The Grants follow the same overall structure of the Government.

At the top, you have Federal Government Grants:

These are generally larger grants open to Anyone in Australia. They are often aimed at specific niche problems, that the Government is willing to fund. These niche problems are often initiated by different departments of the Federal Government and have secured funding from the government for their own project. For Instance, grants related health, medicine and well-being are often sponsored by the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC). Other departments focus on, and secure funding for grants in other areas.

Then there are State Government Grants

These are medium sized grants given to individuals and organisations to tackle State specific problems. Being Based in Queensland, a lot of our customers are also Based in Queensland, so we'll start there.
